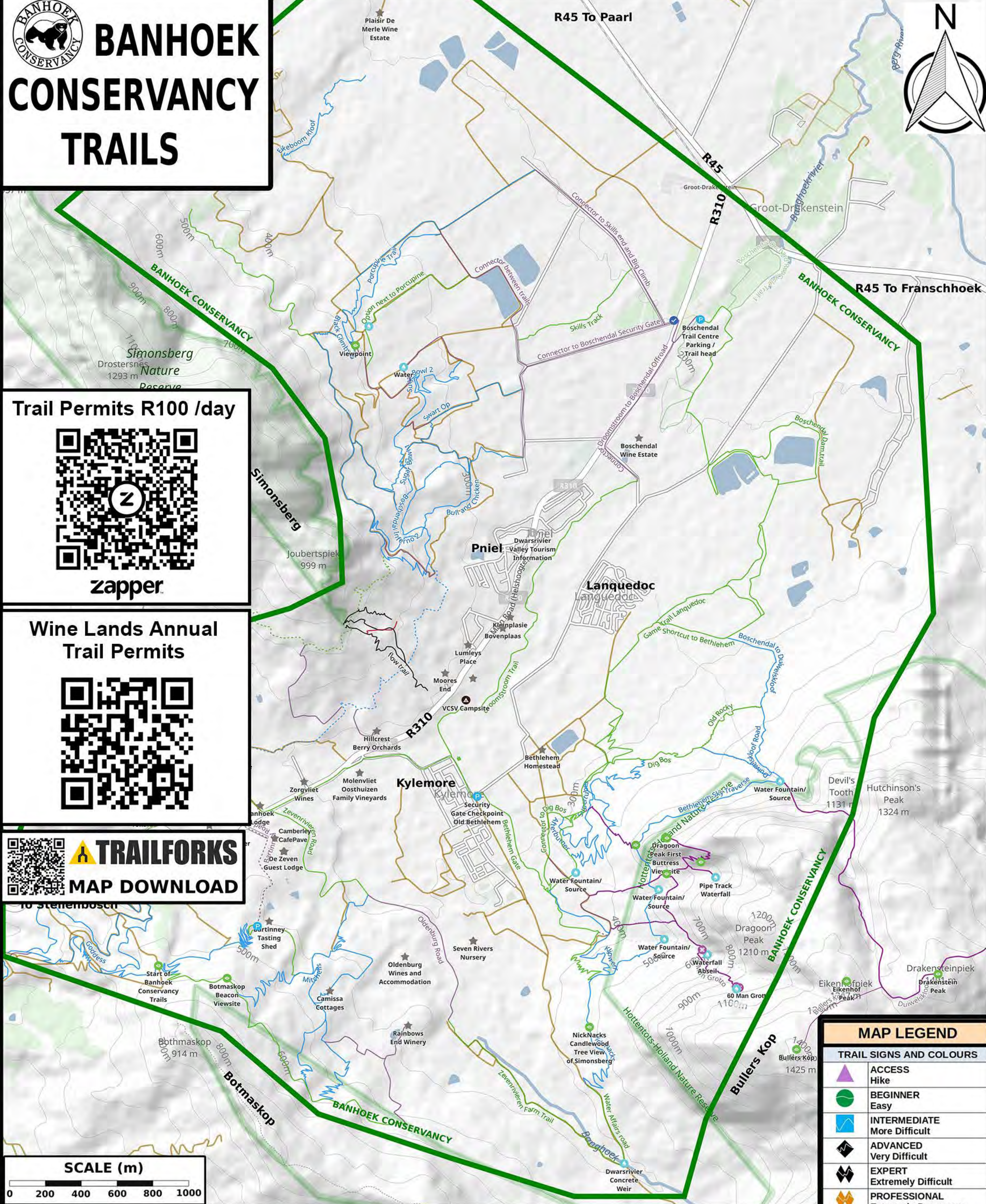

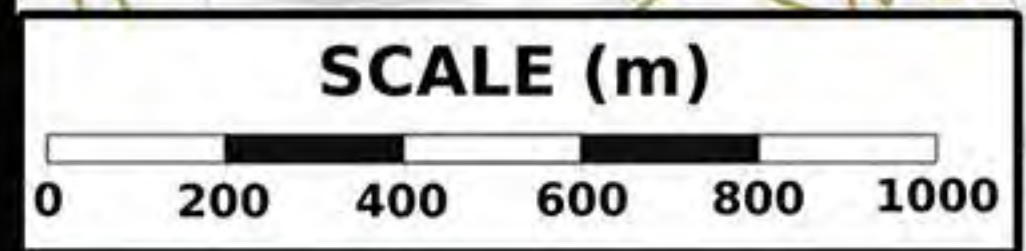

Trail Usage Rules

- 1 To ride the Banhoek Conservancy Trails you must be a member of the Banhoek Conservancy or must be in possession of a valid Day Permit.
- 2 You must show your permit to whoever you meet on the trail if requested to do so.
- 3 Night rides are not permitted.
- 4 You may only ride on the marked routes.
- 5 Observe all Trail markings.
- 6 Give way to anybody on the Trail. These trails cross over working farms. The farm workers and owners have Right Of Way.
- 7 No combustion motorised vehicles are allowed on the Trails.
- 8 Do not pick any Crops or Flowers.
- 9 International Mountain Biking Association (IMBA) rules of the Trail Apply.
